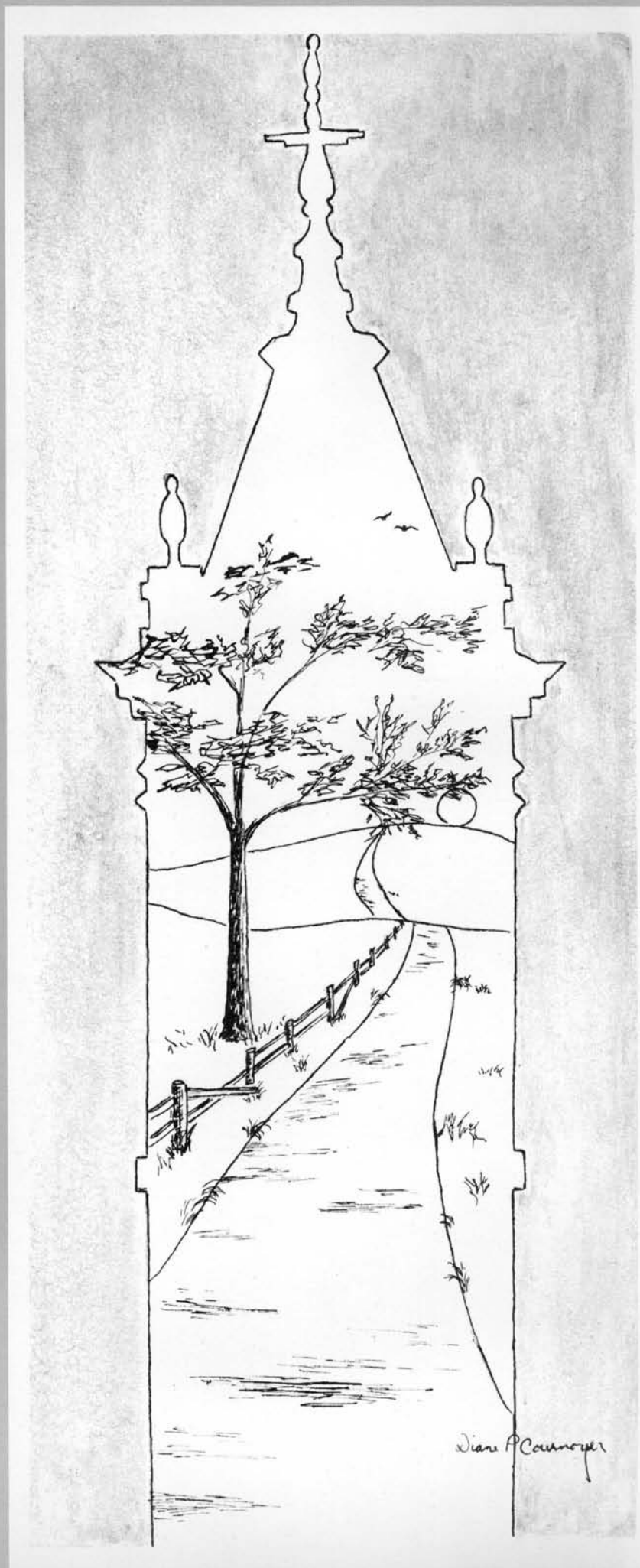




# THE CHOSEN PATH

hindering our view and hampering our travel.

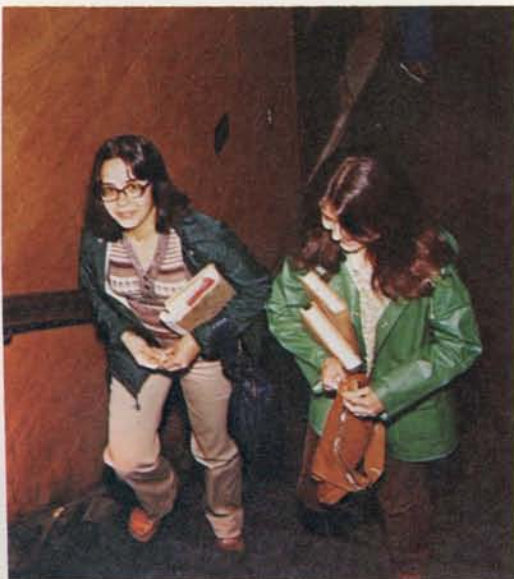

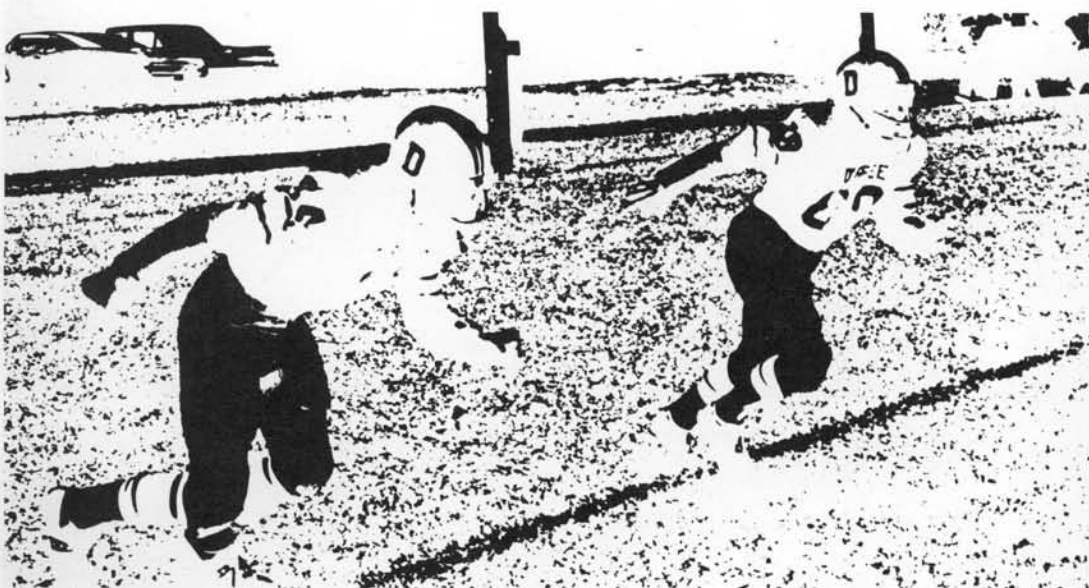






THE 1976

## THE 1976-77 STATE CHAMPS

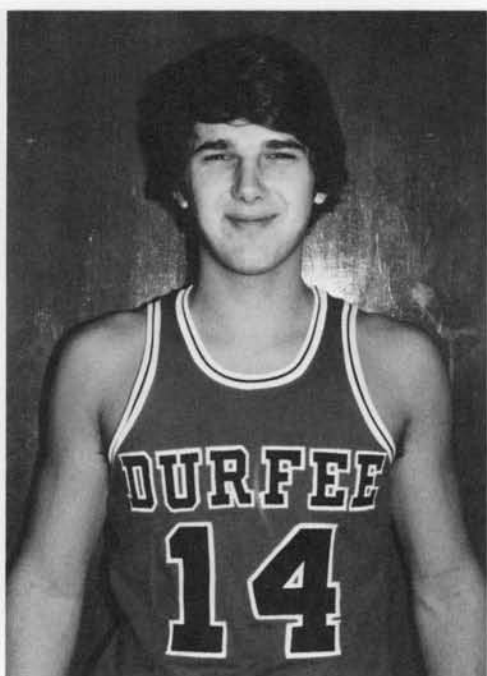

Such individual efforts can explain successful wins; but when you win games by 30 and 40 points, something else has to be going for you. The extra strength and assistance

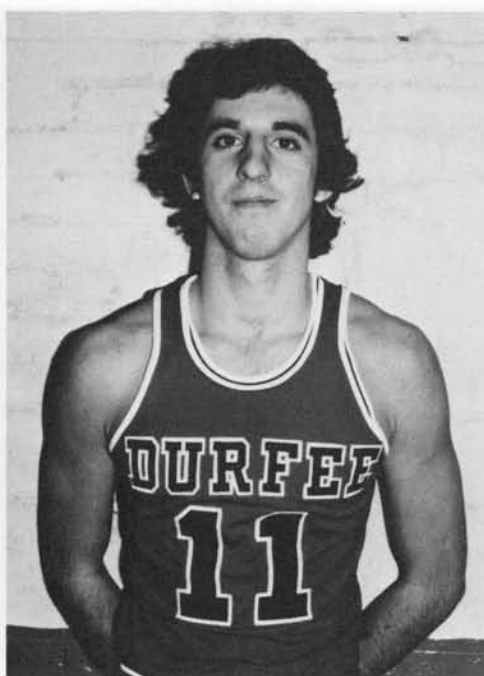

Though lost to an injury for much of the season, Rick Yarbough should be back in time to help the Toppers' cause in the 1977 tourney.

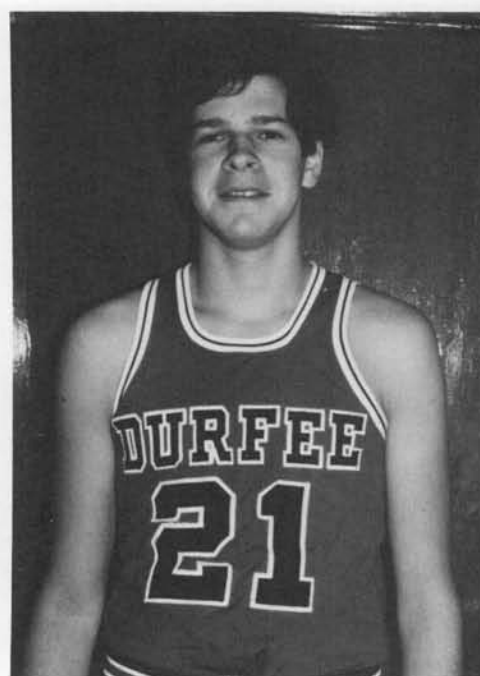

This year's hockey team showed vast improvement over the previous three years.
