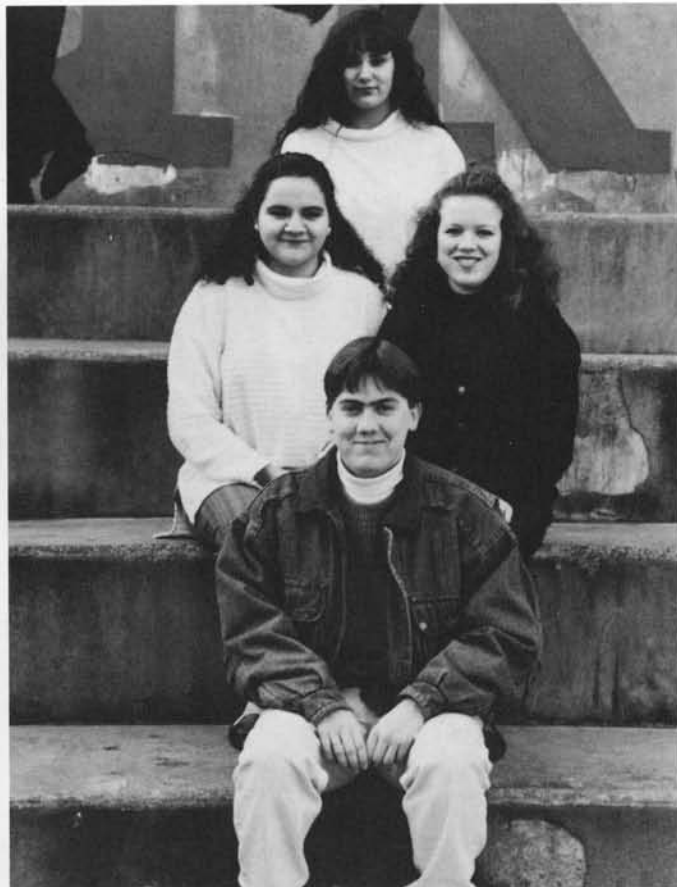

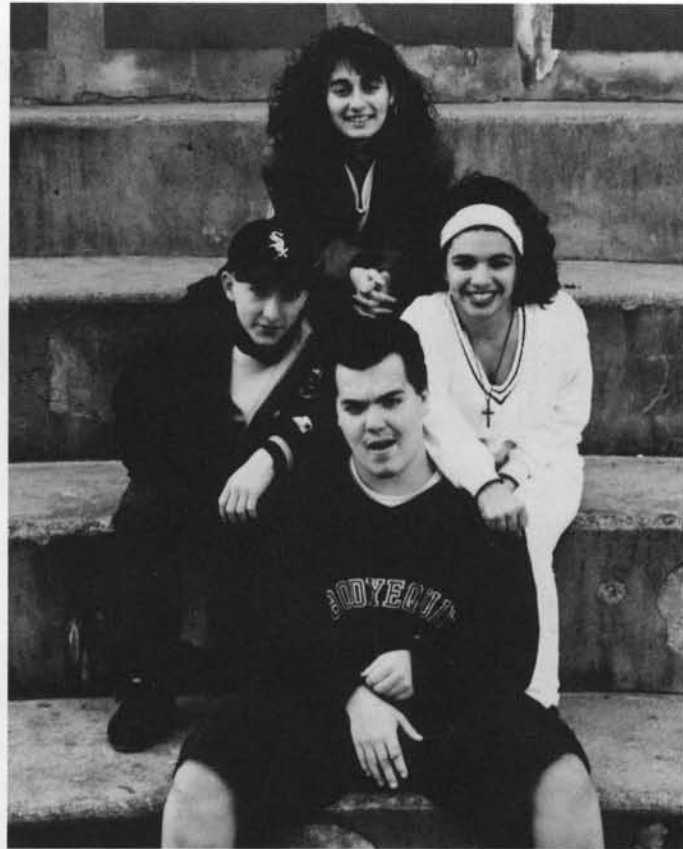

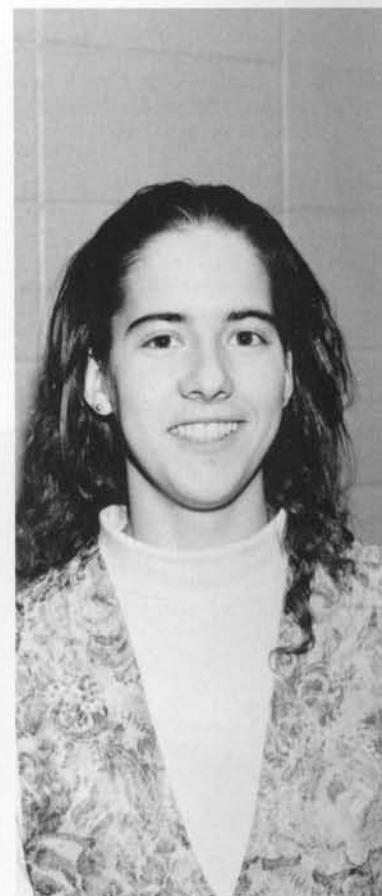

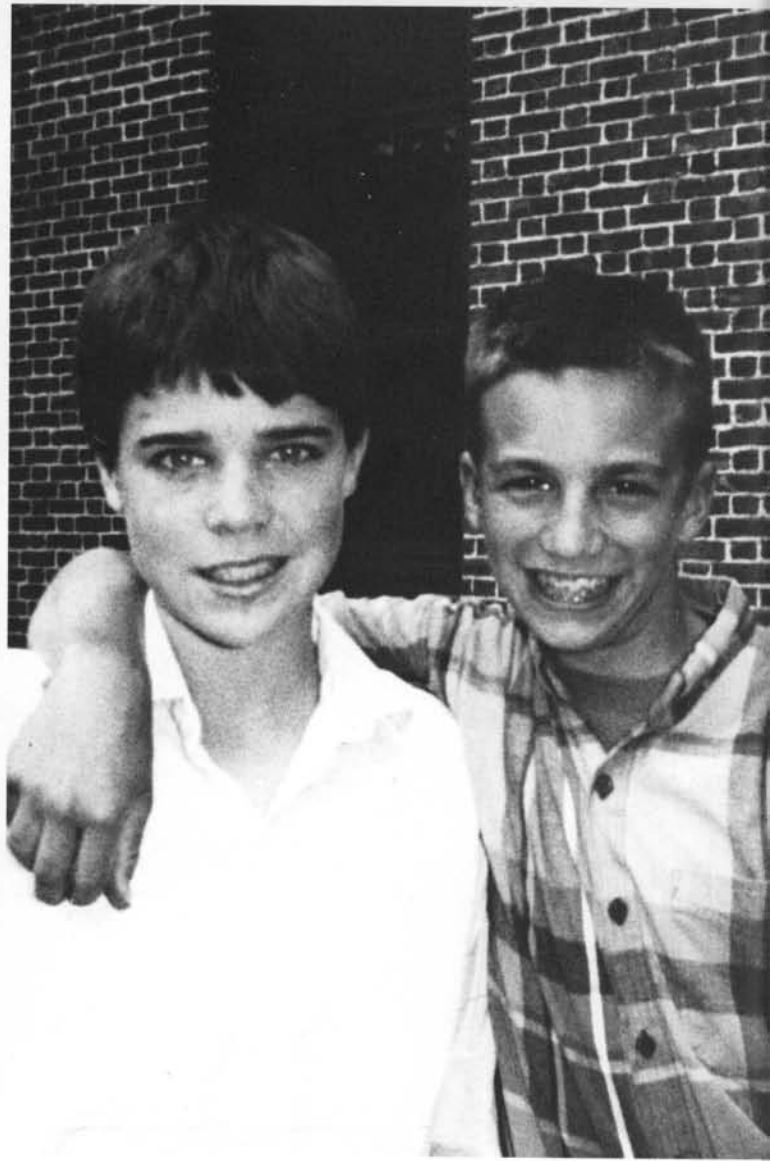

In our four years spent in Durfee, the graduating class of 1993 has collected many memories. Born on September 4, 1989, we've experienced new beginnings, bittersweet endings, the taste of victory, the agony of defeat, tragic deaths, political wars, and political stepping stones.

In 1989, we entered Durfee High School, not yet sure what to expect. First on the agenda was voting for the class officers to

represent the class of '93. Amy Pettine became president, while Keeley Cole became vice-president.

In November, Mikhail Gorbachev approved the destruction of the Berlin Wall, separating West and East Germany. Soon after was the invasion of Panama to capture Manuel Noriega.

Also in 1989, the San Francisco earthquake occurred. It destroyed most of the city and left the population in shock.



In June, the Massacre of Tienanmen Square, Beijing brought many college students to their death after they protested their government for the rights of a democratic nation.

Nineteen-eighty nine proved to be a good year for Durfee athletics. Field hockey, volleyball, girls' basketball, girls' cross country, boys' swimming, softball, and baseball earned spots in the State Tournament.

The Marching Band was advised by a new Band Director, Dennis Robinson.

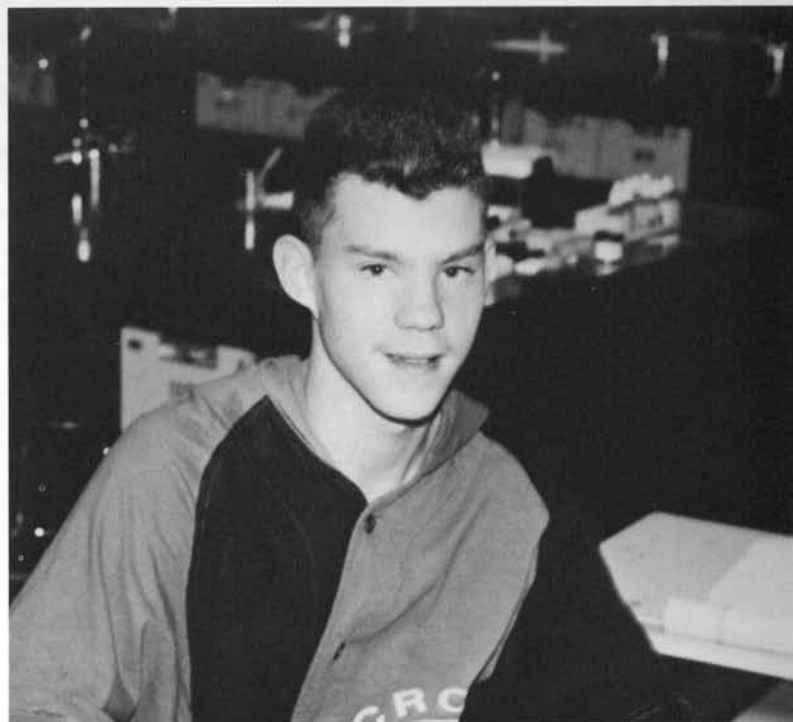
There was a tragic death in 93's first year at Durfee. Douglas Carvalho died of a drug overdose on October 4, 1989. This inspired a group of students to form Durfee Against Drugs, better known as D.A.D. This year the first D.A.D.

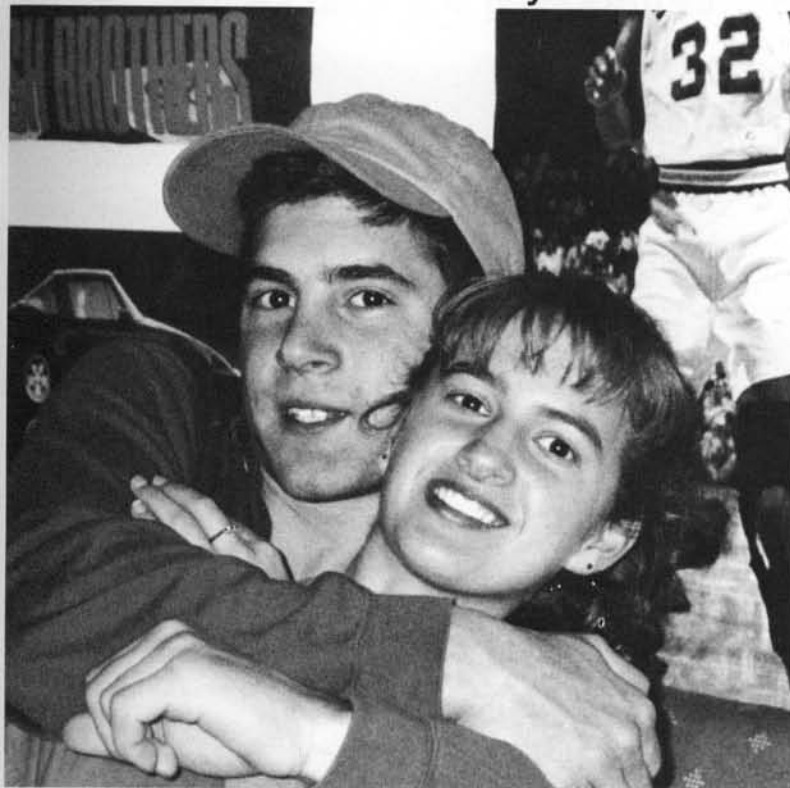
Girls' cross country became State Champions for the first time ever. They were the only other team besides boys' basketball to ever accomplish this.

Students had a chance to travel to Europe this year. They visited Germany, Switzerland, France, and England.

President City Council Robert Bogan became Mayor of Fall River when Carlton Viveiros resigned after thirteen years as mayor to serve as clerk of the housing court. A special election was held and John Mitchell was elected Mayor.

The new Henry Lord Middle School was built this year, beginning a new era for students in the city's South End.



In the fall, Student Government members attended school committee meetings to debate the distribution of condoms.

Nationally, there were also the hearings of Clarence Thomas, who was charged with sexual harassment by Anita Hill, while he was up for being appointed to the Supreme Court.

In ninety-one the class of '93 went on a field trip to Boston to attend a college fair to get ready for searching for a school.

Richard Lynch, a social science teacher passed away on January twenty-fifth.

The Junior Prom was held on May fourteenth, at the Venus DeMilo in Somerset. The theme of the prom was "Wonderful Tonight."

The Theatre Company put on two productions this year, **Into the Woods** and **Theatre Night Review**.

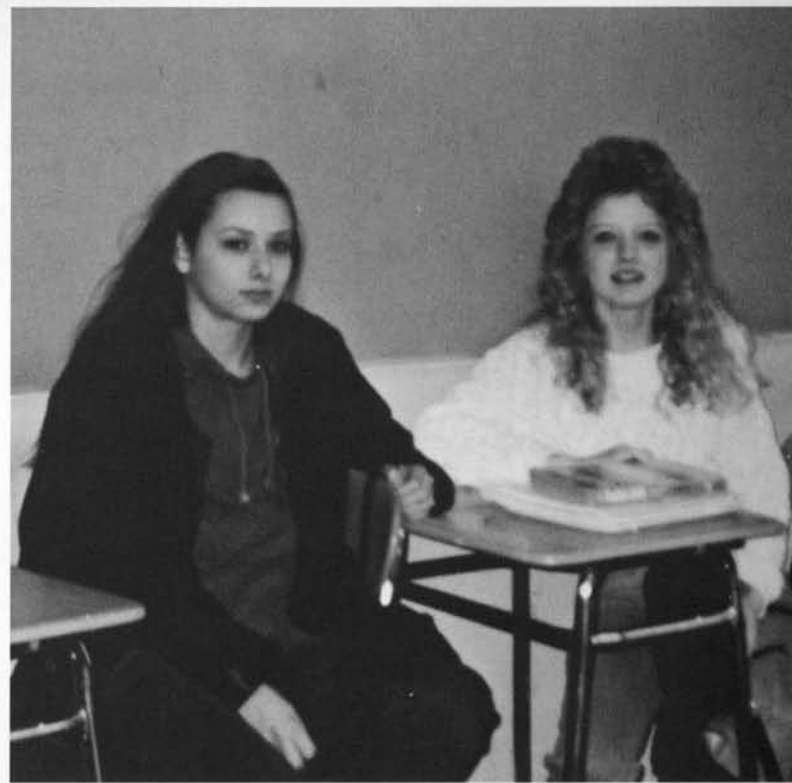
After Mr. Panos officially retired, Mr. Albert Attar was appointed as our new principal. Mr. Clarke was named principal at Talbot Middle School.

On January 20, Bill Clinton became the forty-second president of the United States. In his inaugural address he "challenged a new generation of young Americans to a season of service."

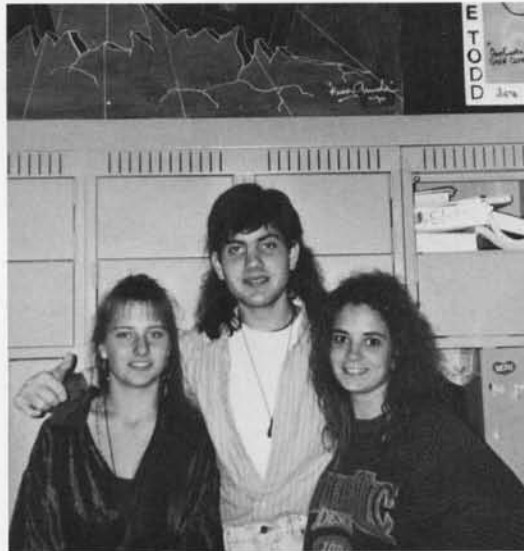
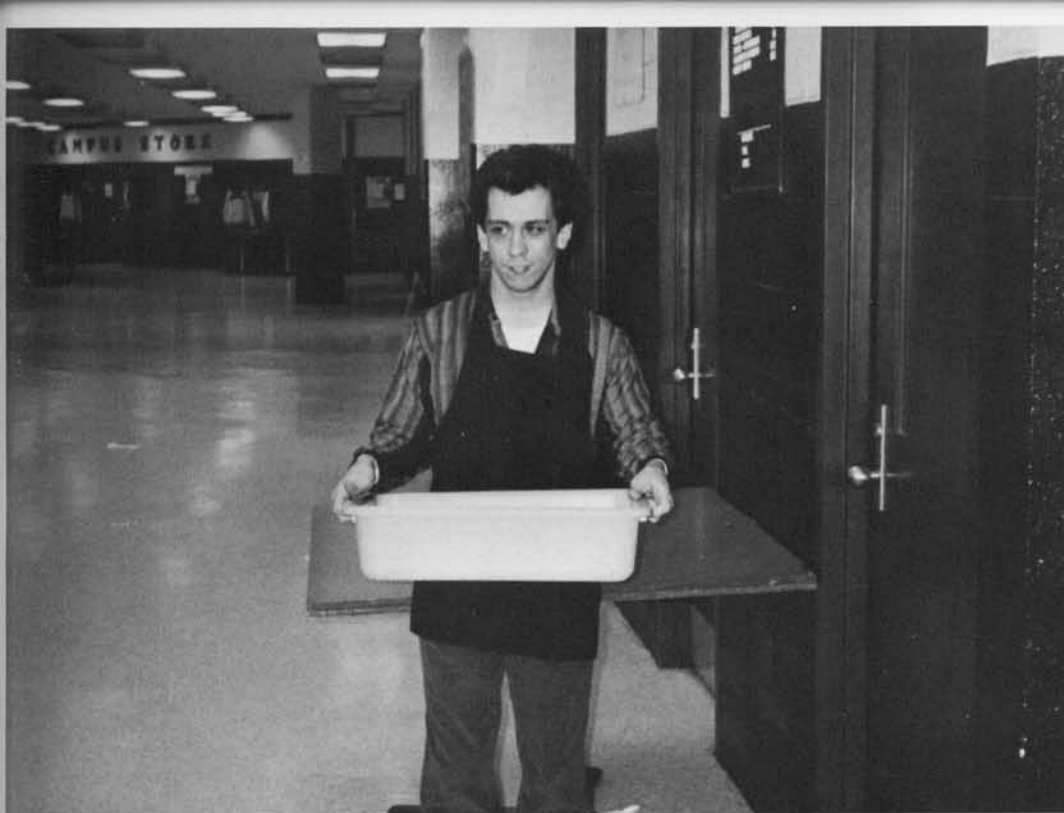
March 18 was the opening night for Senior Follies. The theme for the class of 1993's senior follies was "Our Guide to T.V."

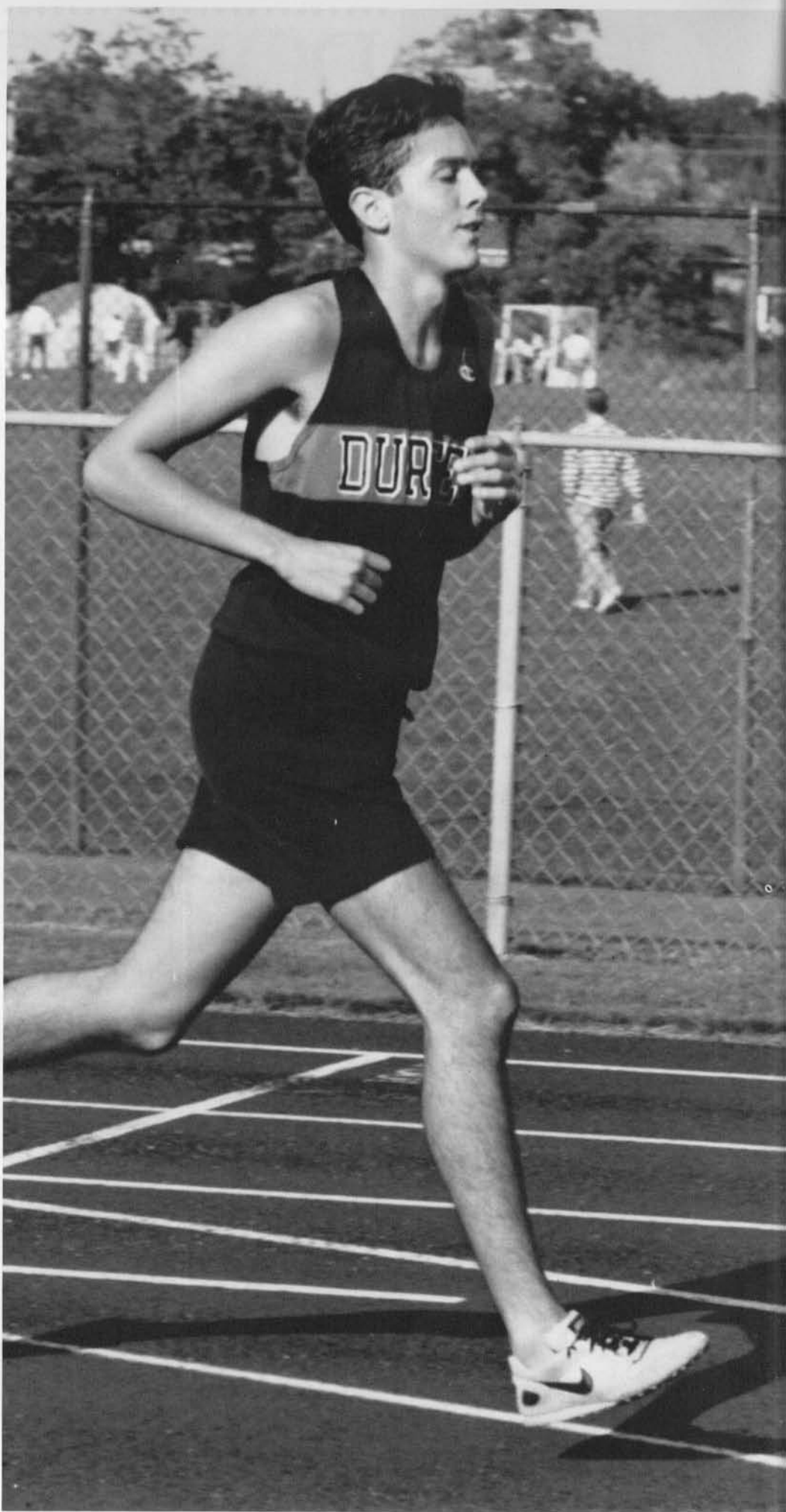

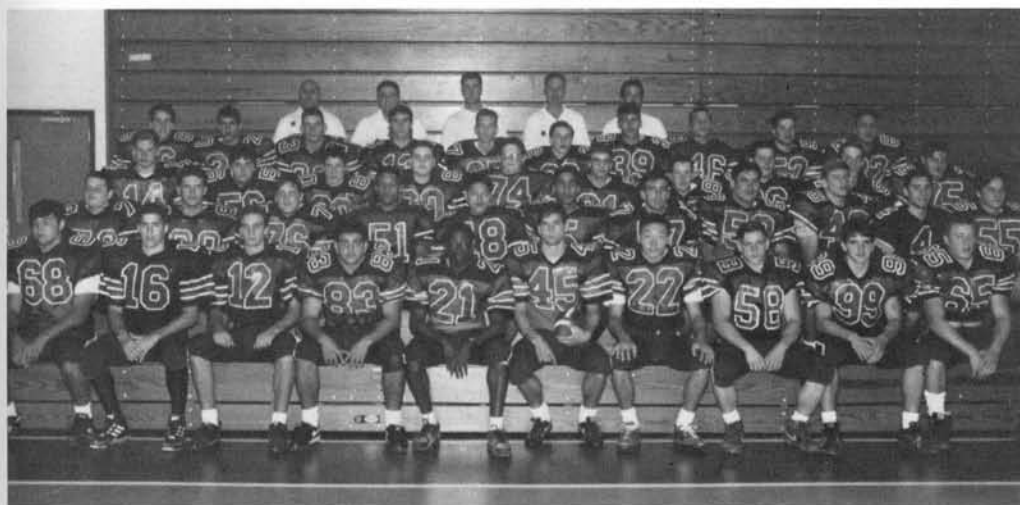

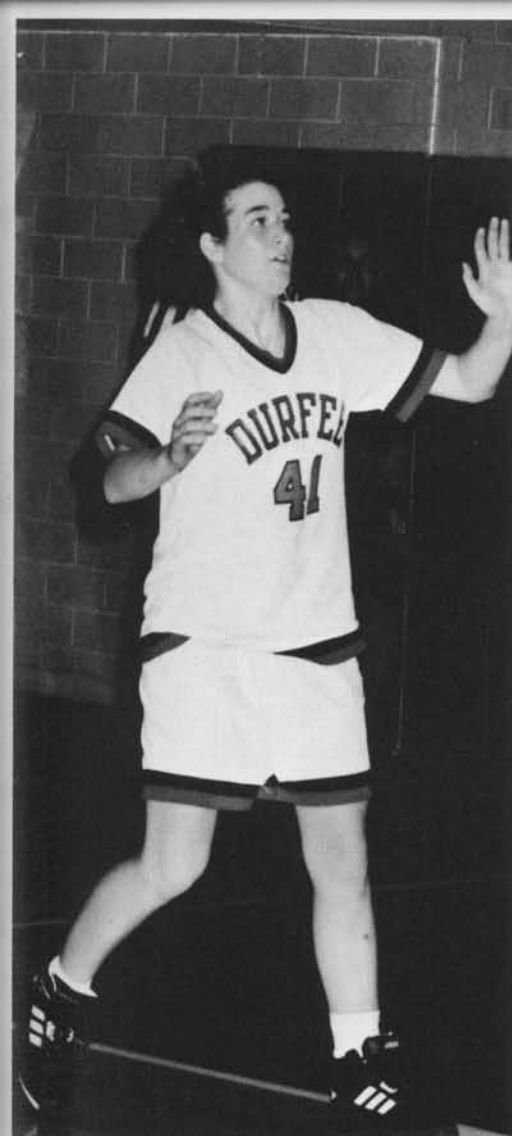

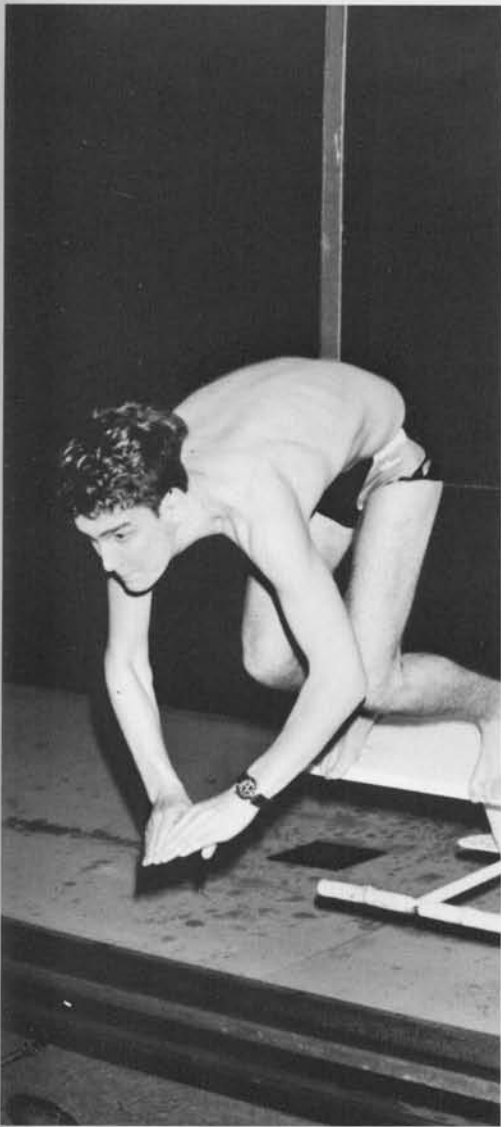

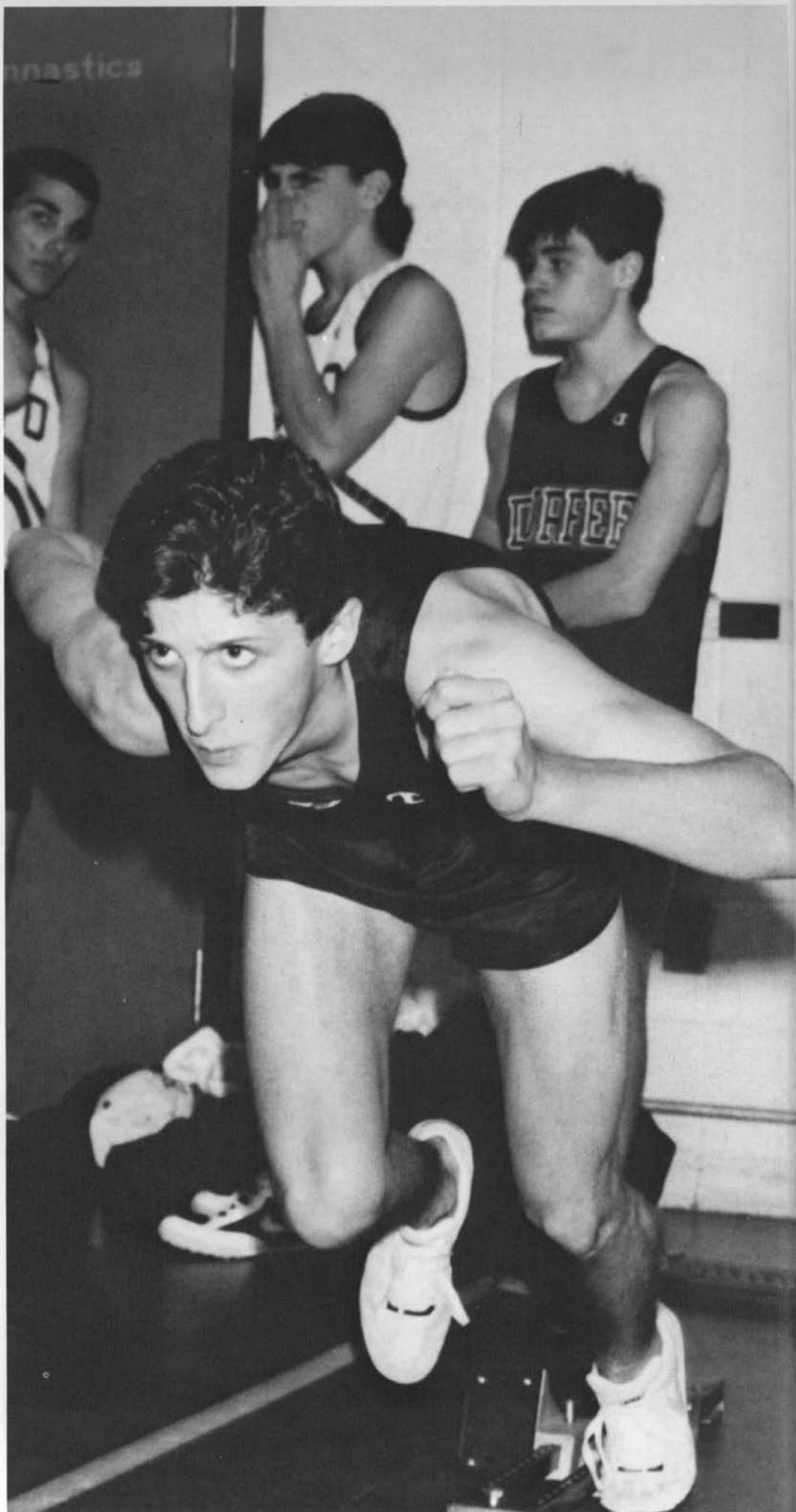

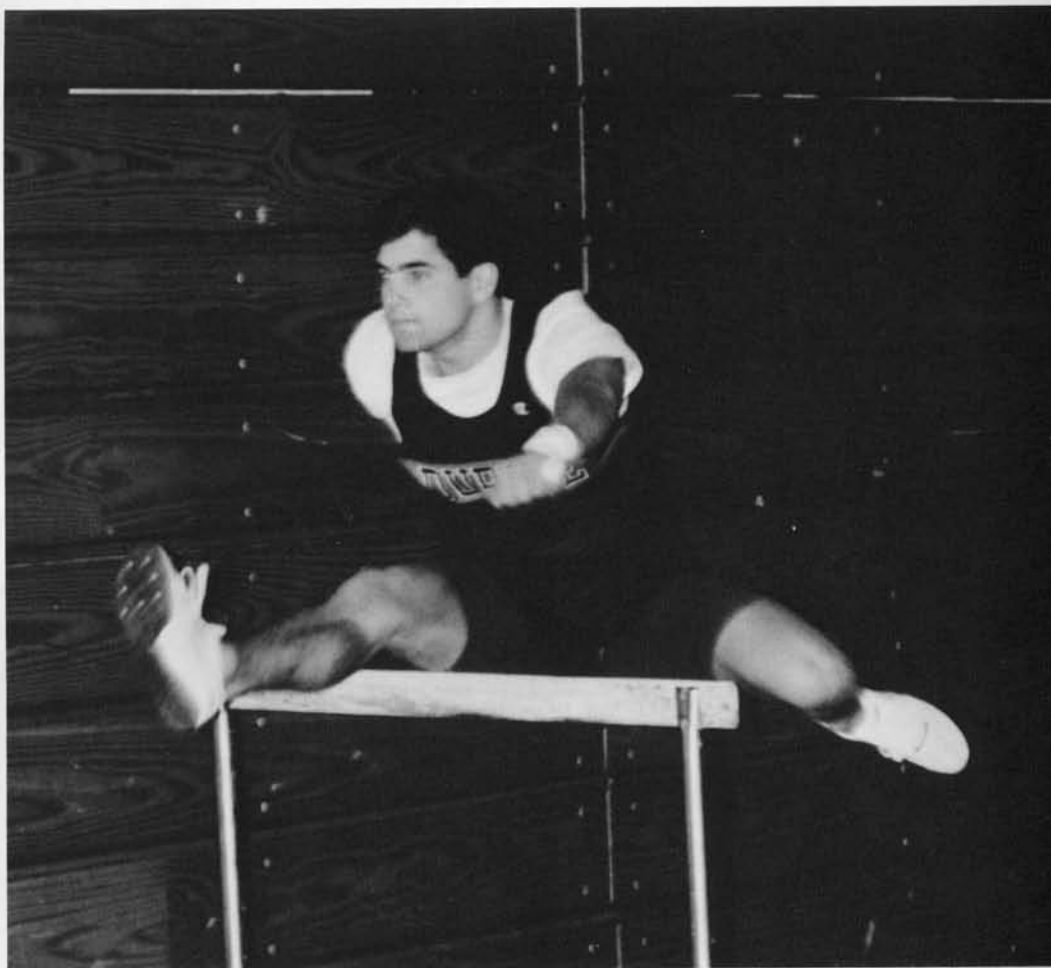

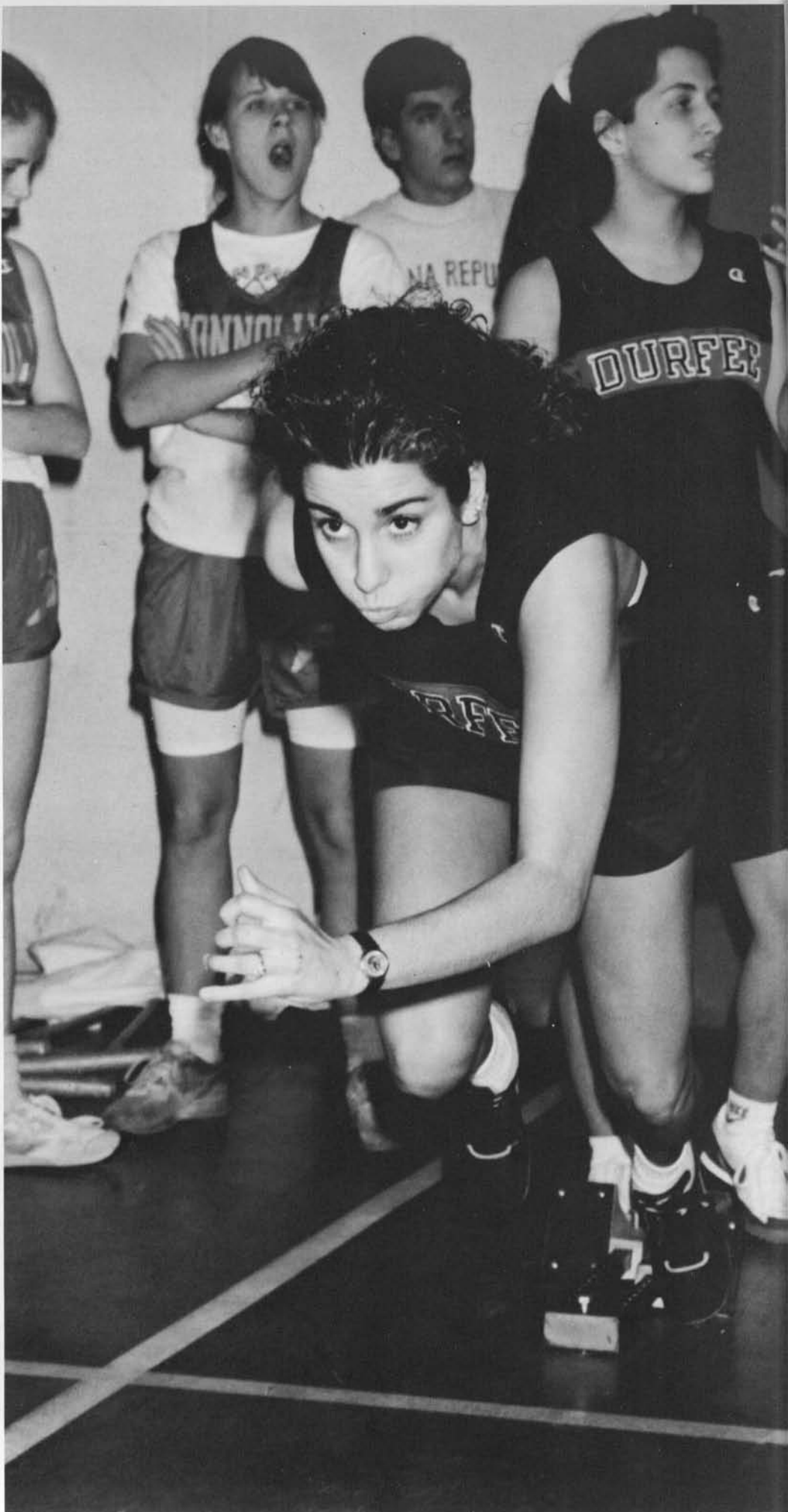

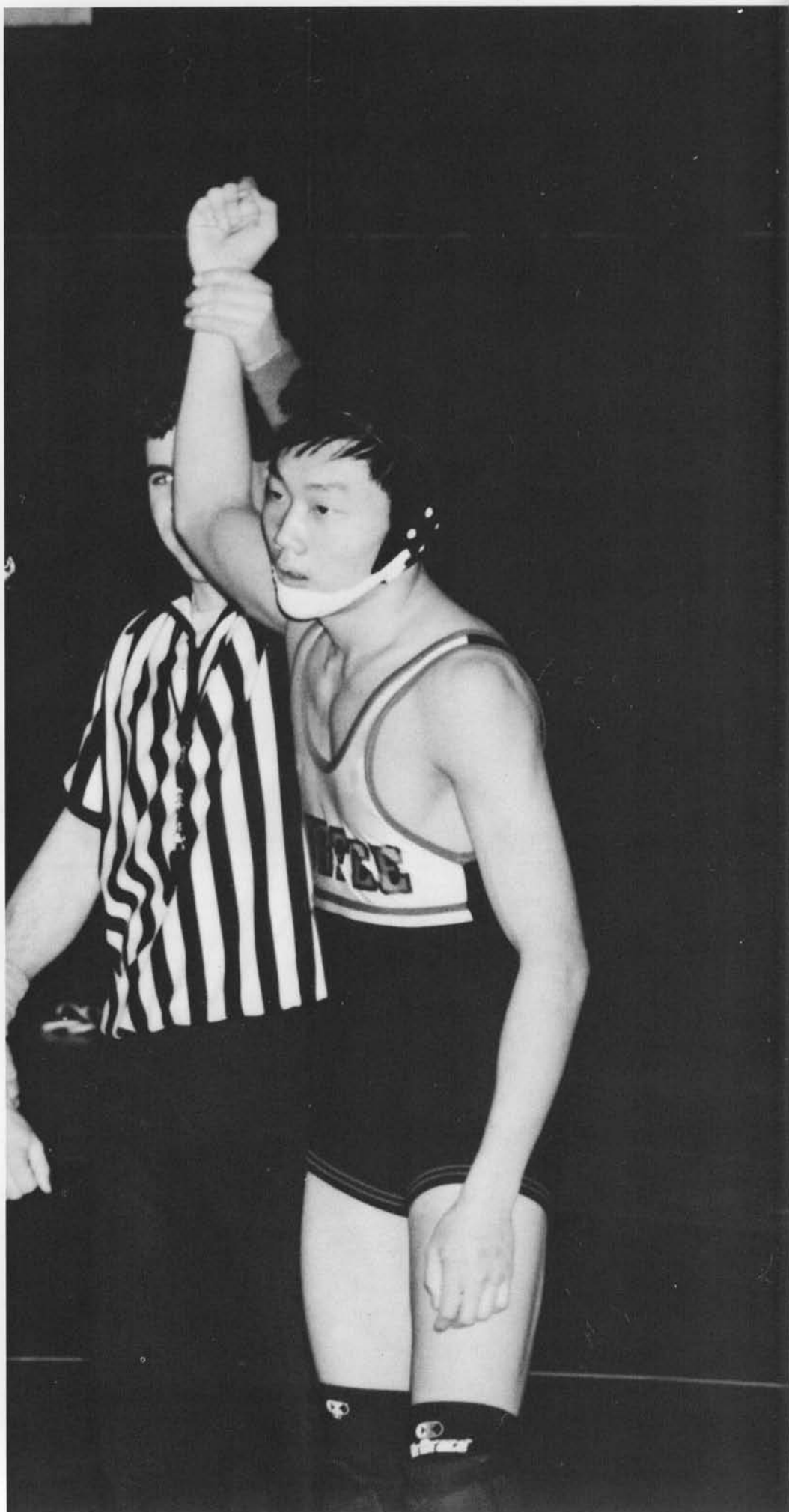

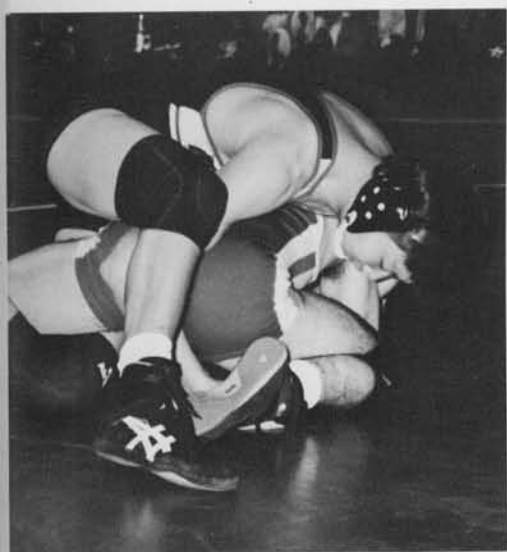

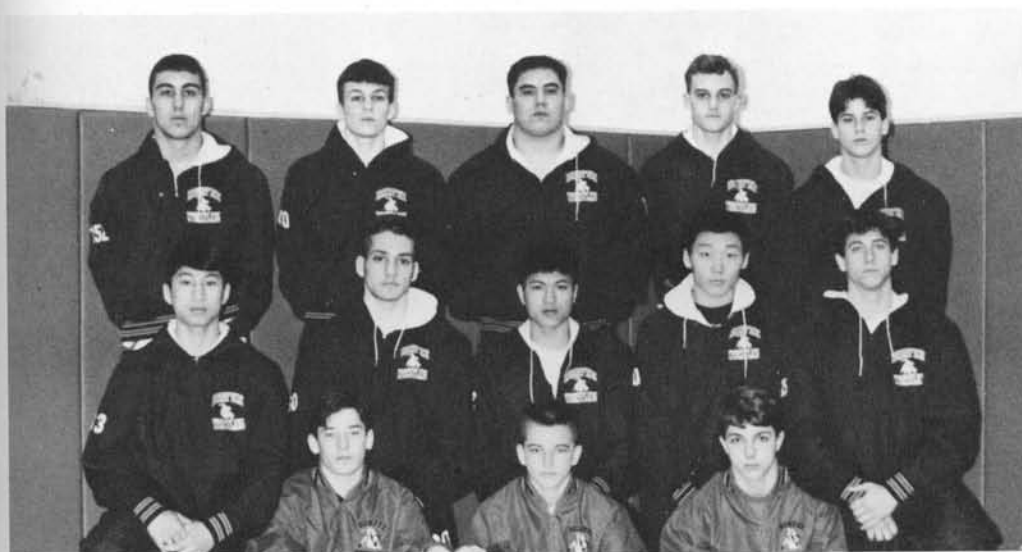

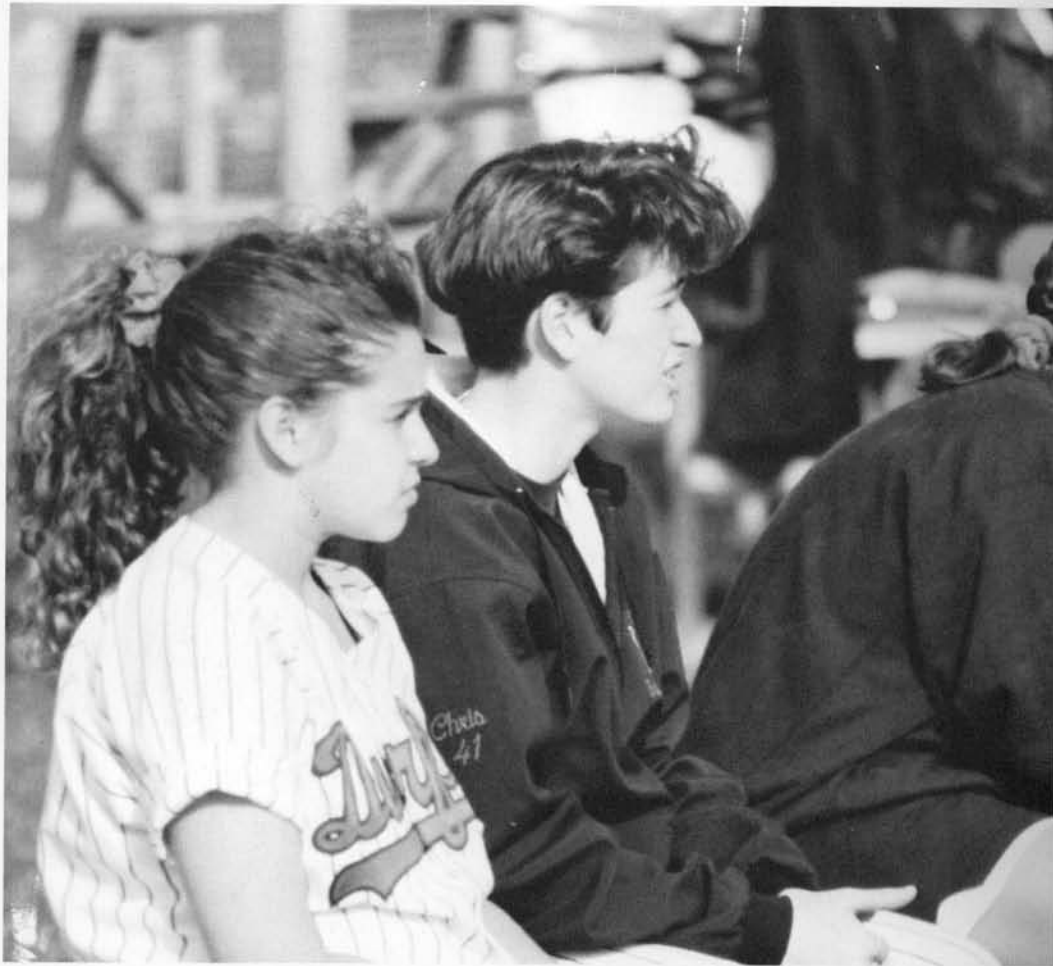

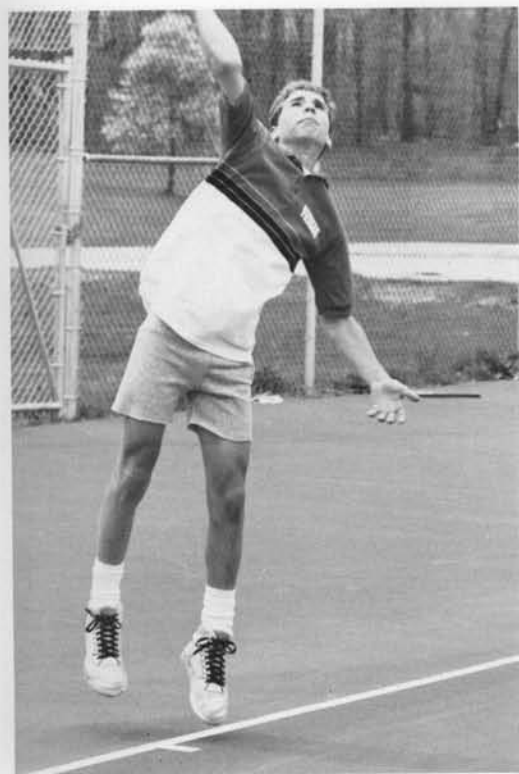

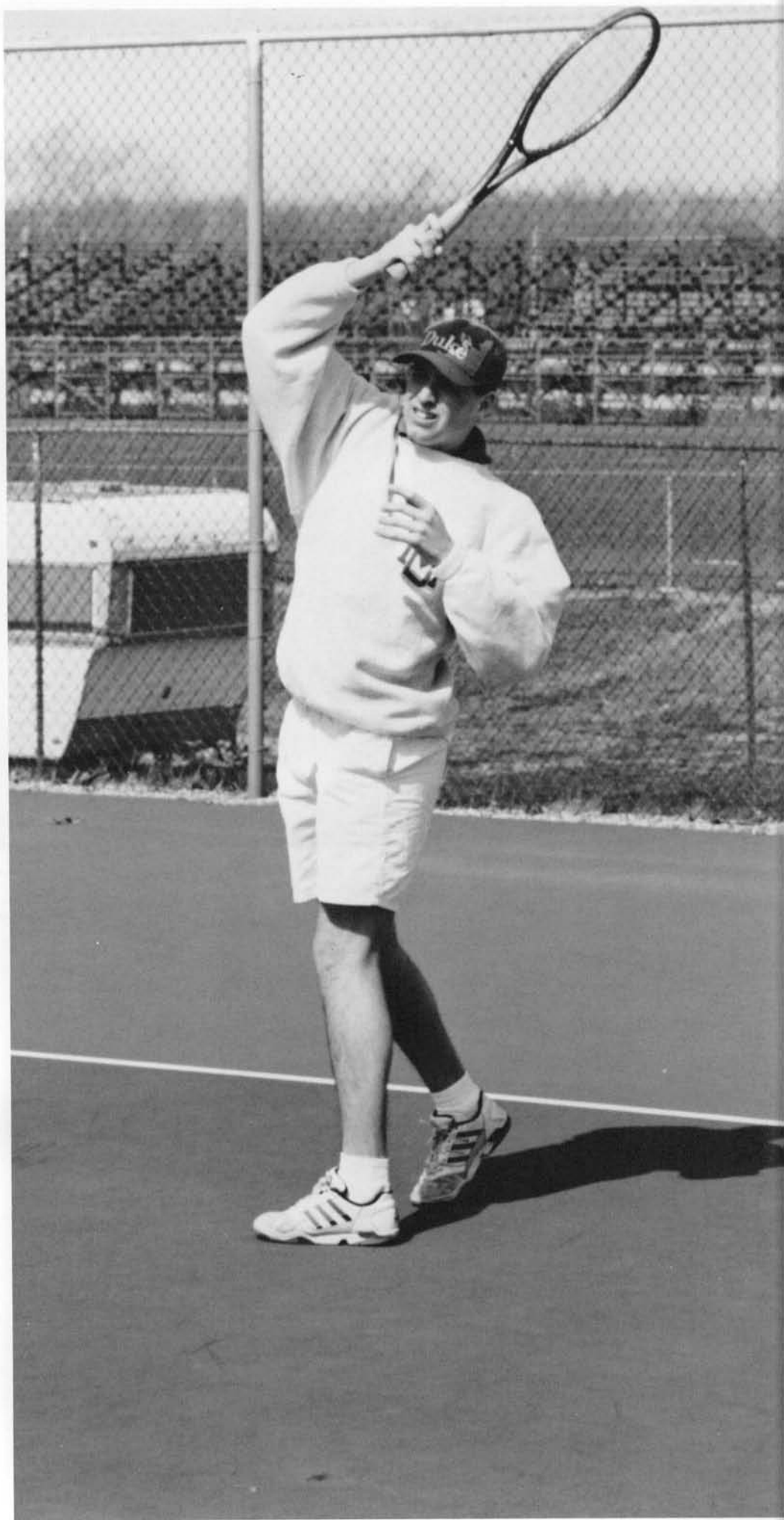

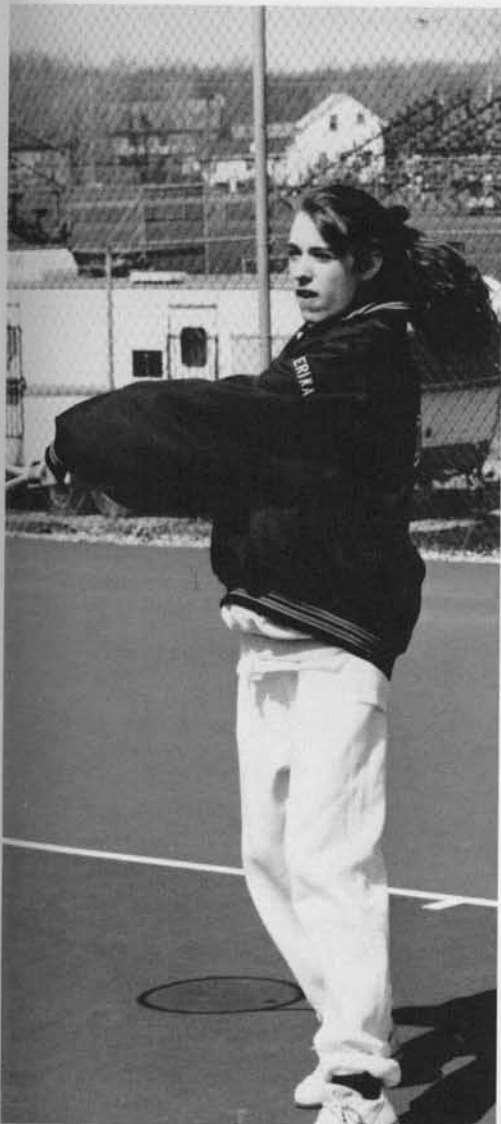

Our four years at Durfee have swiftly come to an end. We will always treasure the memories, but it is time to move on.

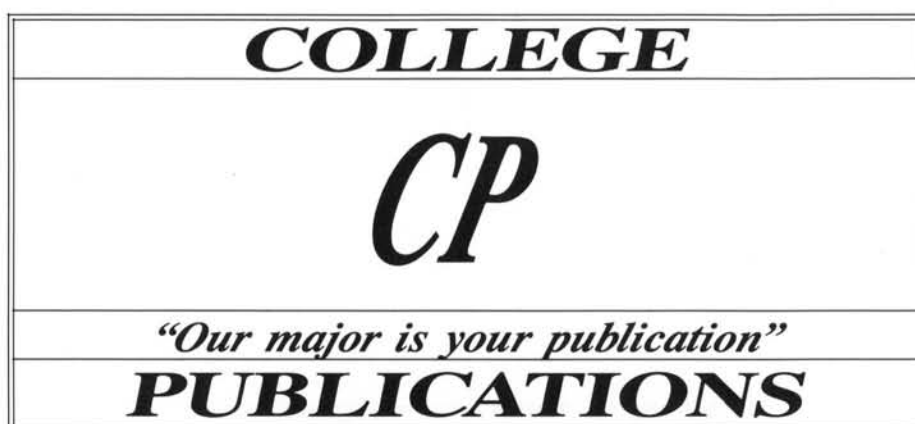

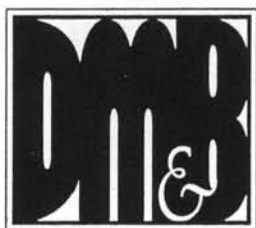
