

SHAREit Version 5.0 - New Commonwealth Catalog Look & Feel



Software changes:

- Screens will scale to fit on various monitor, tablet, and phone screens and sizes. Widgets like the homepage and patron FAQ page are still being worked on to be scalable
- Search results will "stack" and adjust as the screen is smaller
- Book covers in results now have buttons for "Request" and "View Details" direct from first search results page
- Staff menu now called the Staff Dashboard no longer tabs, but boxes of categories
- All the same features and menus no processing steps will change
- Addition of a Quick Menu where specific pages can be favorited and assigned shortcuts
- Searchable Staff Menu a search box on the staff page allows staff to search for features within the staff menu. To customize this list, do the following:
 - 1. Log in as staff
 - 2. Click the My Account drop down in the top right
 - 3. Go to Your Quick Menu
 - 4. From the left side, click Add to include a feature in your Quick Menu
 - Shortcut keys are applied in the order features are added to the Quick Menu. For example:

the first item added to the list will use the shortcut Ctrl+1 and the last item added will use Ctrl+0)

• Ten items can be added to the Quick Menu

We'll let everyone know when the new interface will go live.

SAILS Library Network E-mail Policy

This policy was adopted by the membership at its March membership meeting.

The SAILS Library Network member libraries utilize e-mail accounts supported by Google for Nonprofits to communicate and conduct business. E-mail addresses are provided to professional, para-professional and administrative staff during their employment.

- Email accounts will be established for staff at the request of the director.
- All email sent must include the sender's name and library affiliation.
 - Staff members should have no expectation of privacy in anything they create, store, send or receive using the Library's computer equipment.
 - Staff members are responsible for saving email messages that should be stored to comply with the Massachusetts Open Records Law.
 - Library director and/or network system staff may have to access e-mail while performing required duties
 - Library director and/or network system staff have the authority to reset passwords and review emails at any time.
 - Even if information has been deleted, it may still be retrievable.
- No one is to use the "all@sailsinc.org" list without prior permission by SAILS staff.
- Staff members may subscribe to network email lists with non-SAILS email addresses.
 - Library administrators must notify SAILS upon departure of staff member with a SAILS email account.

Waiver of privacy rights. Staff-members expressly waive any right of privacy in anything they create, store, send or receive using the SAILS e-mail account. Staff-members consent to allow the director and or network system staff access to and review of all materials created, stored, sent or received by staff-members through any SAILS e-mail account.

Circulating Equipment Reminder

Many of the SAILS libraries are circulating equipment and kits that are not supposed to be shipped back to the owning library via delivery. Some items are fragile, and the components need to be counted, etc., when

they are returned. Staff may tell the patrons not to return the item to another library, but that request is not always abided. We want everyone's patrons to use and enjoy these items, but they won't last long going via delivery.

For example, please remind staff not to accept MOBY backpacks from patrons for check in and send them back to Mattapoisett, Rochester, or Marion in delivery. Patrons need to be told to return the backpack to the owning library.
