Google Apps Training

SAILS has a not for profit / educational membership to Google apps. If you have a SAILS gmail account you also have access to all the Google apps as well as a ton of storage space! For free! Many of you have used the Google office products, similar to Microsoft Office, but I'm guessing most of you are not familiar with these. What SAILS hasn't done yet is a good job of advertising. These workshops are a first step.

If you're interested in learning more about the following features, don't wait to register to attend. At this workshop you'll have an overview of how to use the following products:

Google Drive - storage for all of your files Google Docs - like Microsoft Word Google Sheets - Spreadsheets - Project plans, budget sheets, organizational tool Google Slides - Presentation product similar to Powerpoint

You'll hear how Google Drive works to safely kept your files online and saved automatically. That you can log into your Google account from anywhere and have access to all of your work. How you have the ability to share your files with co-workers to collaborate or allow others to only view and/or comment.

There will also be plenty of time for Q & A. These sessions will be presented by Laurie Lessner.

Barcode Orders

SAILS will be submitting the quarterly group order for item and patron bar codes on September 14th. Submit your order using the online order form (see link below). You must include a specific quantity - the number of bar codes on a roll can vary. **Do not** fill out the order form if you are unsure of the starting number - contact me (Debby) first and I can get it for you.

We must have a combined order of 25,000 to submit the order. We will not be placing another order until December so please check your inventory today.

Subfield Z on DVD-SETs

We've noticed that there has been an increase in DVD TV Sets missing |Z in the call numbers. If you do not enter your call number properly, patrons' holds are not filled.

Circulation Staff - if you have a patron complain that their hold on a dvd set is not being filled, email catsupport@sailsinc.org immediately. Do not try to fix this yourself!

- If you are circulating the entire set, the |Z is: |ZA FULL SET
- If you are splitting up the set, the |Z is: |ZDISC 1&2 and so forth.

It does not matter what your call number is before the |Z but there is a 40 character limit. Here are a couple examples:

- DVD WALKING SEASON 6IZA FULL SET
- DVD WALKING S 6|ZDISC 1&2

9XX - Libraries that are using 9xx, update your call number immediately after you run the Load Bibs with Orders report. It does not matter if you aren't sure how you are going to circulate it, just put: |ZA FULL SET or |ZDISC 1&2
